



Stitched Gift Tag Templates


This simple gift tag project uses patterns of straight stitches and back stitches. Use 2 strands of floss for the patterns and 4 strands for the text. The gift tags can double as ornaments or even name placeholder cards for a holiday gathering.

SUPPLIES NEEDED:

Ecru Mill Hill® Perforated Paper, ruler, pencil, large sharp scissors, small embroidery scissors, six-strand embroidery floss (DMC 321, 699, 995, and 820), size 5 embroidery needle, single hole punch, and bakers twine.










If you're unfamiliar with counted cross stitch, the intersection of lines on the grid represent holes, like this: :::::: These designs are intended for 14-count needlework. One inch contains 14 holes. 1 inch
